

Community Recreation Leadership Training
Fieldwork placement opportunity with Centre Greene

First Year Placements:

After-school activity leader

This placement is intended to help the CRLT student develop their skills in the area of activity planning, leadership and evaluation within our after-school program.

There are several options for activities depending on the day of week chosen for the placement. These include leadership of arts and crafts, gym games, environmental workshops, or any aspect of recreation with the approval of the after-school coordinator.

Under the supervision of the after-school coordinator and the development director, the following learning objectives will be evaluated:

- Creation a lesson plan for the weekly activity, including weekly goals and objectives, and progression in the activity. This will be based on the CRLT lesson plan model.
- Animation and leadership of weekly activity, including preparation before the participants arrive.
- Evaluation of the results of the weekly program based on participant response.
- Assistance to the after-school staff during snack time, homework time and free play following homework.
- Integration into the after-school program, act in a professional manner and develop interpersonal relationships with the participants, parents, and Centre Greene staff.
- Attendance at meetings with agency supervisor on a regular basis for feedback sessions.

Please note that the above objectives have been set in accordance with the CRLT elements of competency, and associated learning objectives.

The placement is for one session of 3 hours per week, between 3:00 and 6:00 pm, day to be determined. There are several positions available, but we can only accept 1 placement per day.
