

# Welcome to Centre Greene's 2009 Summer Day Camp

Centre Greene's Summer Day camp is thrilled to offer your children the opportunity to experience the many summer activities, sporting events, and cultural festivals of our wonderful city, as well as the fun of swimming, of arts & crafts, of wonderful day excursions, and much, much more! Conveniently located close to the downtown core, Centre Greene's Summer Day Camp will provide busy families with the fun and peace of mind they need at summertime. This year's camp will, without a doubt, be fabulous!

Camp activities are planned around different themes. Each week an activity calendar is posted in the foyer of the Centre and distributed to parents. Please take a moment to read and discuss the week's activities with your children. In this way, your family can prepare accordingly.

Camper enrollment changes throughout the summer and your children will meet new kids and form new friendships. Our camper/counselor ratio is a maximum of 8 campers to one counselor. The campers will be divided into three age groups, 5-6-7 year olds, 8-10 year olds, and 11 to 14 year olds. The teen leadership camp continues this year with new challenges, and exciting activities. The teens will be helping to guide their summer activities, while learning new leadership skills.

Our camp has some basic ground rules that must be followed by all campers. These rules are in place to ensure everyone's safety and well being. Any camper who is unable to respect these rules will be asked to leave the camp on a temporary or permanent basis.

## **The camp runs on a weekly basis for 8 weeks**

Week 1: June 29 to July 3\*\*

Week 2: July 6 to July 10

Week 3: July 13 to July 17

Week 4: July 20 to July 24

Week 5: July 27 to July 31

Week 6: August 3 to August 7

Week 7: August 10 to August 14

Week 8: August 17 to August 21

## **Part-time Campers**

The camp accommodates part-time campers (minimum of 3 days per week.) The days must be selected during registration and are subject to availability and are not moveable.

## **Camp Hours**

**Camp begins at 9:00 am sharp and runs until 4:00 pm sharp.**

The children, if away on an outing, will return to the Centre by 4 pm at which time they may be picked up. On certain outing days, campers need to arrive by 8:30am, and the camp pick-up will be extended to 5 pm. All parents will be notified in advance.

**Please note** that for practical reasons children may not be picked up before 3:45 pm unless the camp director receives a written note or a telephone call from the responsible parent arranging an alternative pick up time. If children are allowed to leave on their own, a written waiver must be given to the camp director.

## **Extended Hours Program**

The camp accommodates your varying schedules with the extended hours program. Children registered in this program may arrive between 8:00 and 9:00 am and be picked up between 4:00 and 6:00 pm. Children who stay for the afternoon extended hours program will be served a healthy snack.

# **Registration Information**

1. Camp hours: 9:00 am to 4:00 pm sharp.
2. Extended hours: 8:00 am to 9:00 am and 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm (at a cost of \$5 / day / child.)
3. Camp Fees include all outings, and transportation.

## **Regular camp day (9 am - 4 pm)**

### **Week 1**

Full time: \$120/child/week

\$220 for 2 children of the same family/week (\$100.00/additional sibling)

Part time: \$35/child/day (minimum 3 days / week)

\$60 for 2 children of the same family/day

\*\*Please note the first week of camp is 4 days, with no camp on the Wednesday

### **Week 2 to Week 8**

Full time: \$150/child/week

\$270.00 for 2 children of the same family/week (\$120.00/additional sibling)

Part time: \$35/child/day (minimum 3 days / week)

\$60 for 2 children of the same family/day

*Sliding scale discounts available with copy of 2008 income tax information.*

## **Extended Hours (8:00– 9:00 and 4:00 – 6:00)**

Extended camp fees are an extra \$5.00/child/day

*Note:* This Extended Hours fee applies whether children stay for only the AM or PM extended hours, or both times.

A charge of \$5 per day will be applied for any child not already registered in our extended hours program who arrives before 8:50 am or stays after 4:00 pm

## **One day –Special Outings Fee**

On certain occasions, you may be able to register for just the outing day of the week, at the rate of \$50.00/day for one child, \$45.00/day for the second child of the same family.

# Camp Rules and Checklist

- Absolutely no iPods, MP3 players, CD players, cell phones, or videogames.
- Clothing, sports equipment, water bottles, sunscreen, and bathing caps should be properly labeled with a nametag.
- Please keep valuable items and money at home.
- Trading card games such as Magic and Yugi-oh are permitted, but absolutely no trades are allowed. This privilege can be revoked at any time.

## **Campers require the following items EVERY DAY:**

- Proper footwear (running shoes)
- A hat
- Sunscreen
- A bottle of water
- A healthy lunch everyday that does not require refrigeration or being put in the microwave, as well as a snack. Extra drinks for hot days are recommended.
- A backpack. This pack will travel with the camper on a daily basis and should be well labeled with the camper's name and phone number (on the inside!). Please remember that whatever the children bring with them to camp, they must carry!!!
- **Mondays and Fridays:** A bathing suit, towel, bathing cap, and a change of clothes. Children who do not bring proper bathing attire will not be able to swim. (Bathing caps are required at all pools for both boys & girls, regardless of hair length.) Bathing caps will be available from Centre Greene at a cost of \$2 each.
- **Super Aqua Club and La Ronde Outings** are the only days campers will be allowed to bring and spend money. Money should not be brought to camp any other days.
- Centre Greene is a **nut-free** zone. Please ensure that lunches and snacks do not contain any peanuts or nuts. All food items that contain the above will be confiscated.
